

Volunteer Conflict of Interest Agreement

CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

Volunteers for Pride Community Center, Inc (PrideBrazos) shall not have any personal or business interest that may conflict with their responsibilities to the organization. In the event any matter comes before a volunteer in which the individual's family has a personal or business interest, the volunteer shall fully disclose said conflict. Leadership of the organization will deliberate to understand whether a substantial and material conflict of interest exists such that the volunteer would need to modify their service or recuse themselves in the entirety. An official letter on letterhead sent in email in PDF format shall explain the decision of organizational leadership in such matters.

VOLUNTEER CONFLICT OF INTEREST STATEMENT
